

LOCAL BOOK & ZINE FAIRS

Vancouver Art Book Fair

"Vancouver Art Book Fair (VABF) is a nonprofit organization committed to the advancement, appreciation and circulation of artists' publishing."

Vancouver Comic Arts Festival

Zine Harvest

Lucky's Books and Comics

Impressive collection of books, small press publications and zines. Lucky's is a community hub that accepts local zines and regularly hosts events.
